No party other than GOSVG shall derive any rights from the Financing Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the Financing.

The following works will be procured under the project:

(a) Design-Build Contracting services for the main cargo port terminal which also includes the relocation of an existing sewer line and road improvement;

Procurement of Contracts financed by CDB will be conducted through the procedures as specified in The Procurement Policy and Procedures for CDB financed Projects (2019), and is open to Consultants and/or Contractors and/or Suppliers from member countries of CDB.

CDB shall arrange the publication on its website of the agreed initial procurement plan and all subsequent updates, once it has provided a no objection.
